# MCC/SPARKLING

## *L'Ormarins Brut Classique*

Elegant, fresh and lively – this wine is rich in minerality with hints of brioche, citrus and apple notes. Good vibrancy on the nose with perfumey notes balancing the ripe fruitiness and fresh lime character. The palate displays a crisp natural acidity, however rounded with a creamy texture and a long, pleasant finish

## *L'Ormarins Brut Classique Rosé*

Attractive delicate salmon pink hue in appearance. Delicious whiffs of charming raspberry and strawberry aromas vie with a peppery spice nuance on the nose. The palate is vivid with lively bubbles of bright red berries and a crisp acidity

## *L'Ormarins Blanc de Blanc*

Vibrant bubbles with a trademark string of pearls rise to the surface. The nose offers sea spray, lime zest, chalk, and hints of orange peel. The palate is tangy with crunchy green apple and lime, then smooths into creamy citrus and subtle biscuit notes from lees aging.

## *L'Ormarins Private Cuvée*

With a pale onion skin hue, L'Ormarins Private Cuvée offers a vigorous bead of fine, pristine bubbles and aromas of yeast with underlying red berries and stone fruit. These nuances are rounded by subtle honeyed note. As you take your first sip, your palate is met with tangy and refreshing flavours of lemon and marmalade

## *Boschendal Brut*

Pale gold with a flourish of delicate bubbles. Enticing lemon cream and almond biscotti precede lovely layers of citrus and a finish of appealing length and freshness

## *Pongrácz Brut*

A timeless, elegant and complex MCC. Delicate yeasty notes layered with toast and ripe fruit, and enlivened by a firm mousse and persistent bead

## *Pongrácz Desiderius*

Rich complexity and a slight green tint that teems with light, lively bubbles complement a raciness on the palate, with nuances of fresh fruit, almond and freshly baked bread

## *Krone Borealis Brut*

Complex yet elegant with hints of brioche, walnut and a zingy finish that leaves a wonderful scent of stewed pear

## *Krone Brut Rosé*

Pomegranate and cut red apple. Fine, creamy mousse with a punch of juicy, rich berry

## *Krone Twee Jonge Gezellen Blanc de Blanc*

Delicate yet coiled on the palate, the lacy texture is pulled taut by a defined, nervy acidity

# CHAMPAGNE

## *G.H.Mumm Cordon Rouge*

Vibrant freshness and exuberant energy excite the palate. Complex and perfectly balanced, the wine reveals rounded, elegant flavours of fruit and caramel

## *G.H.Mumm Le Rosé*

Energetic, bracing and fresh. Elegantly structured, it delivers flavours of fragrant summer fruits and a long, bright finish, balanced by the succulent sweetness of red berries

## *G.H.Mumm Demi-Sec*

Rich golden colour with fine bubbles. The nose is expressive, featuring aromas of ripe fruit, honey and hints of brioche. On the palate, it offers a balanced and generous sweetness, with flavours of candied fruit, apricot, and subtle notes of vanilla and honey. The finish is long and smooth

## *Moët & Chandon Impérial Brut*

Creamy texture, with bright notes of green apple, almond and honey

## *Moët & Chandon Impérial Rosé*

Lovely raspberry aromas with a powerful Champagne background

## *Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label*

Pale gold, with lovely bubbles and flavours of lemon, grapefruit, ripe apple, almond and toasted bread

## *Armand de Brignac Gold*

The grapes Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay are used to produce almost all French Champagne, although there are small amounts of Pinot Blanc, Pinot Gris (which is called Fromenteau in Champagne), and Arbane and Petit Meslier are vinified as well

# SAUVIGNON BLANC

## *Hampton & Co*

Fresh and crisp, with tropical fruit aromas and flavours created in contemporary style to awaken your senses

## *Cape of Good Hope Altima*

Bold tropical granadilla and gooseberry notes tinged with grapefruit and lime zest. Every year the vineyard battles against nature in order to produce highly concentrated, powerful wines with a flinty, mineral character true to the quartz rock in which it is grown

## *Iona*

Gooseberry, some asparagus, green fig leaves and a dusty minerality. Nice acid to finish

## *Southern Right*

A flavour explosion of grapefruit, orange peel, bell pepper and white pepper, with notes of star anise and a beautiful vegetal component

## *Diemersdal*

Brilliant lemon-lime colour and a complex nose with an array of tropical fruit, ripe fig and gooseberry

## *Warwick First Lady*

An abundance of fig, passion fruit, gooseberry, grapefruit and lime aromas

## *Springfield Estate Life From Stone*

Highly concentrated, powerful wine with a flinty, mineral character true to the quartz rock in which it is grown

## *Durbanville Hills Collectors Reserve*

Full concentrated wine with the aromas carrying through onto the palate. Typical cool climate Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing, lingering acidity that plays well with the lees-aged body of the wine

## *Creation*

Light straw-yellow in colour, with glints of green. The invigorating, salty bouquet, reminiscent of the fresh sea breezes caressing our vineyards, is complemented by delightful hints of green fig

## *De Grendal Koetshuis*

Pale straw in colour with a clean nose displaying aromas of crisp pineapple, fresh papaya, Asian pears and an underlying creamy richness from extended lees contact

# CHENIN BLANC

## *Fleur du Cap*

Fresh aromas of tropical fruit, with notes of lime and oak spice. Hints of citrus on the palate, complemented by a touch of butterscotch and a lingering, crisp finish

## *Cavalli Unoaked*

A fresh, elegant Chenin Blanc laced with crisp layers of tropical and stone fruits complimented by notes of vanilla, honey and spiced oak, with lovely freshness leads to a well balanced wine with great palate length and a bright finish

## *Ernst & Gouws & Co*

Unoaked, with a lively floral, apple and mineral aroma, and a great freshness in the mouth

## *Spier 21 Gables*

Soft aromas of dried apricot and ripe tropical fruit, with hints of oak and vanilla. Rich, with good acidity and white peach, almond paste and creamy notes

## *Zevenwacht*

Honey and pineapple combine with crisp fruit and fresh acidity on the palate

## *Fryer's Cove*

This Chenin Blanc is bright with acidity that supports mouthwatering flavours of lemon, nectarine and white peach. The lingering minerality provides a vibrant and satisfying finish, with subtle oak spice from maturation in large oak barrels

## *Cape of Good Hope Riebeeksrivier*

Good rainfall brought much needed relief from the severe drought experienced in the preceding 3 years. Warm periods during winter and fluctuating temperatures during spring resulted in smaller berries and some uneven bunch development

## *Ken Forrester FMC*

# CHARDONNAY

## *Rupert & Rothschild Baroness Nadine*

Lively aromas of peach blossom, lemon, gooseberry, and mango supported by nuances of delicate nougat and lightly toasted macadamia nuts. Fresh acidity with a lingering soft textured palate

## *Durbanville Hills The Cable Way*

Rich straw colour with green tint. Combination of orange peel and pineapple flavours. Full bodied wine with sweet fruit and citrus flavours, rich creamy texture with a long finish

## *Spier Seaward*

Juicy stone fruit flavours balanced by a nice acidity

## *Glen Carlou*

Vibrant and fresh with hints of tropical fruit, citrus and balanced oak

## *Lourensford Dome*

Ripe pineapple, melon and orange blossom on the nose, with hints of lemon cream, grapefruit and dried apricot. Subtly oaked, with flavours of white peach, cashew nut and caramel, and great acidity

## *Warwick The First Lady*

Floral notes, rich in naartjie peel and ginger. Fresh, with a touch of toasty French oak

## *Vergelegen Reserve*

The wine shows an attractive lemony yellow-green colour with a complex nose of citrus, white peach, pineapple, spice, citrus blossoms, apricot and buttered toast aromas

## *Steenberg*

On the nose; notes of lime, peach, pear drop, butterscotch and vanilla jump out of the glass. The palate is soft and smooth with hints of stone fruits, citrus and custard like creaminess on the finish. Bright acidity brings freshness and length to the wine

## *Holden Manz*

Elegant flavours of citrus and white blossom, knit with a minerality, some salinity and complex acidity to provide a long, smooth finish

## *Hamilton Russell*

Prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality

# WHITE BLENDS/OTHERS

## *Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc*

Full-bodied, with complex dried exotic fruit, apricot and peach. Some acidity in the aftertaste

## *Anthonij Rupert Cape of Good Hope Riebeeksrivier Caroline*

Good rainfall brought much needed relief from the severe drought experienced in the preceding 3 years. Warm periods during winter and fluctuating temperatures during spring resulted in smaller berries and some uneven bunch development

## *Spier Creative Block 2*

A complex nose of green apple and fresh herbs, with a palate of tropical fruit, melon, asparagus and fresh nettle

## *Vuurberg White*

A true field blend of grape varieties sourced from Stellenbosch vineyards and Swartland vineyards. The composition is Chenin Blanc 39%, Viognier 15%, Semillon 15%, Verdelho 12%, Rousanne 8%, Grenache Blanc 7% and Chardonnay 2%

# ROSÉ

## *Hampton & Co*

A blend of fresh, crisp Sauvignon Blanc flavours and Merlot's red berry fruits. Made in a just off-dry style

## *Anthonij Rupert Jean Roi Cap Provincial*

Instant appeal from the pale copper pink blush colour which continues with its alluring aromas of peach blossom and honeydew melon. The palate is vivacious with the immediate impact of bright, juicy melon, peach and nectarine flavour making itself felt

## *Mirabella*

Generous aromas of strawberry, raspberry, kumquat and rhubarb. Notes of apricot, red plum, shortbread and cinnamon delicately join the bursting flavours of red apple and watermelon on the palate

## *Nederburg Wine Master Grenache*

Tempting aromas of ripe orange melon, cling peach and subtle caramel with a shy hint of cherry and pomegranate

## *Château d'Esclans Whispering Angel (FRA)*

Very light and refreshing, strikingly pale pink in colour. Fresh, fruity aromas, with plenty of juicy strawberry and berry fruit on the dry palate

## *Boschendal Chardonnay/Pinot Noir*

Richly flavoured, with creamy citrus notes of Chardonnay and concentrated red berry and cherry flavours of Pinot Noir

## *Waterford Rosemary*

This is a perfect summertime wine, with an alcohol content of below 11% and low acidity, which are by-products from the care that goes into making this rosé

## *Minuty M*

Red-berry notes dominate the wine's bouquet. The crisp, juicy fruits are round and appetizing on the palate. A slight touch of sweetness tempers this vivacious vintage, a splendid introduction to the rosés of Provence

# PINOT NOIR

## *Creation*

Deep ruby in colour, gleaming and inviting in the glass. The intensely fragrant bouquet shows a mélange of red berry aromas, elegant vanilla, and a whiff of wood spice. These follow through on the full-bodied palate where soft, supple tannins contribute to the dense structure. A superbly balanced wine with a lingering, memorable after-taste

## *Bouchard Finlayson Galpin Peak*

Floral aromas, with expressive, complex fruit development on the palate. More strawberry than dark fruit, but plenty of plum, with spicy cherry notes expanded through the impact of carefully selected French oak barrels

## *Hamilton Russell*

Notes of ripe red cherry, fresh raspberry, violet, sage and rosemary, complemented by lightly toasted vanilla, chestnut, earth and leather

# SHIRAZ

## *Spier Seaward*

Beautiful layered aromas of mulberry, violets and subtle pepper and anise. The mid-palate is balanced with concentrated fruit flavours and smooth, dense tannins

## *Saronsberg Provenance*

A nose of ripe plum, pepper and liquorice, with dark chocolate and plum on the palate. Silky-smooth and balanced

## *Kevin Arnold*

Dark fruit, clove, pepper and spice lead the aromatics of this Stellenbosch Shiraz

## *Von Sir*

Dark and robust, a true embodiment of Shiraz excellence. This wine delights with luscious fruit aromas, a palate of rich dark chocolate, and a tantalizing hint of spice on the finish

## *FAT Bastard*

This full-bodied wine shows freshly crushed black pepper aromas with hints of cinnamon and cloves on the nose with lots of brambly red berry fruit and well-integrated vanilla tones

# MERLOT

## *Fleur du Cap*

Ruby in colour, with notes of rich fruit, subtle cherry and oak spice. The oaky backup is well balanced, with gentle tannins and lots of fruit on the palate

## *Anthonij Rupert*

Tempting herb notes overlay riper plum and berry fruit aromas. In the mouth hedgerow fruit or berries and plum flavours are joined by deeper, darker inky nuances of cocoa and cedar. A deceptively soft textured palate also shows intensity with spice and earthiness and some powerful muscularity from time in oak

## *Creation*

Multi-faceted, like a finely cut ruby in the glass – with a bounty of fruity, spicy aromas to invite you in. On the palate, rewarding dark chocolate and mocha combine with generous ripe berry flavours, supported by the firm structure derived from judicious oak maturation

## *Meerlust*

Deep, youthful purple colour with a ruby rim. Intense dark brambly fruit on the nose, mulberry, liquorice and damson plum with hints of dark chocolate and spice, tempered by a stony minerality. The full bodied palate offers generous, ripe, pure Merlot fruit with refreshing acidity, structured yet silky tannins and pronounced length and minerality

## *De Grendel*

Classic elegance and dignity. A mélange of red, black and blue berries, ripe blood plums, all present on the nose and in the soft, fleshy, even lush flavours

## *Vergelegen Reserve*

Ripe plum colour with a ruby rim. The nose shows ripe fruit flavours, black cherries, plum, spice and a touch of chocolate. The ripeness of the fruit is balanced by fresh fruit acidity with soft wood and fruit tannins. The aftertaste is long and lasting

# PINOTAGE

## *Beyerskloof Pinotage Reserve*

Intense dark red colour. Promising blackberry aromas upfront with lively sweet cedar oak in the background. Blackberry and plum flavours, with the light hints of cedar oak aromas from barrel maturation. A deep fruity middle core, complex and layered with a long juicy after-taste

## *Spier 21 Gables*

Deep ruby red on the eyes, this is a Pinotage to sink into slowly. The nose exudes violet aromas and sweet, ripe blackberries and cherries which overlay a hint of graphite

## *Doolhof Dark Lady*

Rich black fruit, almond and black cherry on the nose. Flavours of deep crimson berry, overlaid by a beguiling chocolate-mocha tone

## *L'avenir*

Deep red with purple edges. Dark chocolate, mocha and ripe banana on the nose. Rich ripe plummy fruit combined with spice, fills the mouth and ends with a long ripe tannic finish

## *Beeslaar*

Vibrant dark plum fruit jumps out of the glass and leads into a medium fuller palate that has beautiful darker red fruit to core and nicely integrated tannins that give good supporting structure. With some aeration this gains flesh and mid palate suppleness allowing the wine to take on a silky textural mouth feel

# CABERNET SAUVIGNON

## ***Boschendal Stellenbosch***

Ripe fruit expression with prominent black fruit and spice, and hints of tobacco and pepper, and some sweet cherry notes

## ***Durbanville Hills Castle Of Good Hope***

Rich ruby red in colour. Mint, cedar, pencil shavings and hints of black currant. Smooth, silky tannins, concentration of red fruit, leather, hints of spice

## ***Ernie Els Big Easy***

Dark-fruit nose, with notes of cassis, mint, baked plum and liquorice. A richly fruited palate backed by chocolate and plum, and a hint of dried herbs

## ***Stark Conde***

Blackberry fruit aromas with tea-leaf and cedar notes. The palate is rich and polished with dark fruit and mocha flavours and a finely balanced acidity. Long finish with the fine tannins typical of a Jonkershoek Valley wine

# RED BLENDS/OTHERS

## ***Hampton & Co***

Accessible and easy-drinking for everyday enjoyment, with juicy red fruit, a hint of gentle tannins and vanilla from the wood treatment

## ***Warwick Professor Black Pitch Black***

The palate is rich and textured with fine grained tannins and a bright and piercing freshness delivered by the unwooded Cinsault component

## ***Rupert & Rothschild Classique***

Aromas of blackberries and blueberries with a note of fresh coriander

## ***Anthonij Rupert Optima***

Opulent but genteel and tempting violet-tinged soft black fruit abundance on the nose. The palate is all about texture: silky, velvety, smooth and simultaneously plush. Ripe plums, hedgerow fruit, cocoa, cedar and spice, cigarbox flavours makes for an enveloping mouthful

## ***Vergelegen DNA***

Compote of berry fruit nicely rounded by chocolate and coffee notes. The tannin structure is round and soft with a lingering after-taste

### ***Meerlust Rubicon***

Very deep, youthful colour, and intense almost purple hue. Quintessential Rubicon nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood, fennel, and intense spiciness. A typical liquorice note also evident on the nose. Still young and intense, the palate is full bodied, structured but packed with fresh dark fruit and rounded tannins

### ***Hogan Divergent***

A very expressive nose of red cherries, plums, sweet blackcurrant, star anise and forest floor. A wine of lightness and elegance but also of substance

### ***Vilafonte Seriously Old Dirt***

Seriously Old Dirt displays a moderately deep but brilliant ruby-red colour. The nose is notably fresh and fruit-forward, with red cherry, plum and blueberry, accentuated by zesty Szechuan & Cayenne pepper

### ***De Toren Z***

Redolent of roses and ripe-for-the-picking strawberries, the refreshing De Toren Délicate is an elegant red blend that combines red's seductiveness with the undeniable drinkability of white. Medium bodied and immeasurably gentle, it offers up an abundance of juicy fruit and velvety

### ***Raats Cab Franc***

The nose entices with its perfume and a garrigue character of Cape fynbos, rosemary, lavender, and thyme with spicy notes of nutmeg, cloves, and star anise. Intense brooding blackberry fruit

### ***Waterford Antigo***

The red, clay, rich soils of this vineyard bring softer and plush elegant fruit to the aromatics. They also create tannins which are rich, soft and sweet

### ***Boschendal Nicolas***

A blend of Shiraz, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Malbec. A wine with an excellent concentration of fruit, with prominent mulberry and plum flavours, as well as black forest cake notes of cherry, cream and mocha. The tannins are well integrated, fresh and chalky, with a rich, smooth mouth feel and persistent spicy finish

### ***Spier Frans K Smit***

These small-lot, complex wines consist of one red and white blend – both world-class collectables. Indulge in an elegantly wooded blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon, along with a red blend that, depending on the vintage, is typically composed of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Shiraz

# DESSERT WINES

## *Pierre Jourdan Ratafia*

Sherbet, Turkish delight and sweet brandy alcohol entice the senses on entry, while the nose reveals pear, rose petal, spice and honey

## *Klein Constantia Vin de Constance (Natural Sweet)*

One of the best sweet wines. Very smooth, with rich dried-tree-fruit aromas

## *Joostenberg Noble Late Harvest*

Sourced from a 29-year-old, organically farmed, unirrigated Chenin Blanc vineyard on Joostenberg. The grapes were "whole-bunch" pressed and naturally fermented. Fermentation and maturation occurred mainly in old oak barrels. The wine spent 8 months in these barrels before being bottled
